



Catalina 22 Reservation Guidelines

Abraham Lincoln Council, BSA

Guidelines:

- Rubber soled sneakers only – No hard sole shoes.
 - Unit must provide their own drinks/snacks.
 - No more than 5 passengers per boat.
 - Unit is responsible for clean-up after use.
 - Unit must provide adults capable of assisting with launching and retrieving of C22.
 - In case of 2 units requesting same date, the application submitted to and approved by the Scout Service Center first will be confirmed.
 - **All participants using the boats are required to be BSA certified swimmers.**
 - All persons on board are required to wear a provided PFD (personal flotation device) while on the boat or near the water.
 - All BSA protection guidelines will be followed, having 2 adults on each boat. The exception will be if both catalina's are being used, then 1 adult per boat is permitted. The boats must remain in sight of each other.
 - The unit is responsible for repairs or damages to any sailing equipment, including, but not limited to, boats, trailers and personal flotation devices, caused by abuse or misuse.
1. Boy Scout or Exploring/Venturing unit must contact the Scout Service Center for a reservation form or download it from the Abraham Lincoln Council web site.
 2. ALL Forms must be completed in full and returned to the Scout Service Center **before** sailing.
 3. The Scout Service Center will contact and/or broadcast e-mail to approved Abraham Lincoln Council C22 "Captains" when reservation requests are received.
 4. "Captains" available for the date and activity will contact the Scout Service Center and then make contact with requesting party.
 5. While every effort will be made to accommodate groups, use is subject to the availability of boats, captains and weather. The final decision to sail or not sail is at the discretion of the Captain.
