Participant Requirements

- Currently registered and active in your Scouting Program
- Completed Unit-Level Youth Leader Training
- Minimum 14 years of age by the first day of the course
- Boy Scouts and Varsity Scouts: Not yet 18 years of age, and have completed NYLT
- Venturers and Sea Scouts: Not yet 21 years of age, and have completed NYLT
- Be physically fit and approved for High Adventure on your current 2012 BSA Medical Form
- Wear proper Field Uniform(s) during the NAYLE Course and bring all required equipment

Program Cost & Information

The NAYLE Program cost is \$355.00, payable in full with registration. This fee covers meals, lodging, training materials, a NAYLE uniform cap, and 2 NAYLE uniform t-shirts.
